If you are new to Scouting, you will notice some of the Pack saluting the flag and some of the Pack with their right hand on their heart. Why? While in Class A or Class B uniform, you salute the flag. If you are not in uniform, you place your hand on your heart.

# What does it mean when you hear 'Signs-Up'?

Part of earning your Bobcat Badge requires knowing the meaning of the Cub Scout Sign. The Cub Scout sign means 'be quiet and pay attention.' So when a leader displays the Cub Scout Sign, he or she is requesting the Pack's attention.

# <u>New P.R.A.Y. Program starting in November</u> (Programs of Religious Activities with Youth)

Religious Emblem Program Pack 475 supports families' spiritual faith growth in their own chosen denomination. Pastor Tweed from our host church LCR, co-facilitates Christian sessions from the *God and Me* (grades 1, 2, 3) & *God and Family* (grades 4 & 5) curriculums.
