#### **Directions**

From Orlando area, SR 528 (Beachline) E to SR407; SR407N to SR405E to Visitor Complex

From the north: I-95 to Exit 215 to SR405E; follow signs to Visitor Complex

From south: I-95 to Exit 212, SR407N to SR405E to KSCVC

There is no physical address for the Visitor Complex. If you are using a GPS use the U.S. Astronaut Hall of Fame address: 6225 Vectorspace Blvd. Titusville, FL 32780 and follow SR405E six miles east. The Visitor Complex entrance will be on your right.

#### Check - in

\*\*\*\*There is a parking fee of \$10 for cars if you arrive before 3:30 you will be charged. If you arrive after 3:30 you will not be charged.\*\*\*\*\*\*

Buses park in bus parking area of Lot 4.

Personal vehicles park in Lot 4 behind the cones. Do not park in the bus parking area. Overnight parking permits will be distributed at 4:15.

#### Check-in begins at 4:15 p.m. in Parking Lot 4 Kennedy Space Center Visitor Complex

Program begins at 4:30 p.m. Please remain in the parking lot as the staff will have to distribute vehicle parking passes.

#### **Age Limit**

**Program is limited to youth age of seven to fourteen years.** We reserve the right to deny overnight participation to any youth not in this age range. All chaperones must be at least 21 years of age.

#### **Overnight Gear**

Bring no more than you can carry. We don't have luggage carts, therefore we recommend your use luggage with wheels. Please bring an air mattress to sleep on.

Rain plan If the forecast is predicting rain please pack your pillows, sleeping bags or any other lose items that are not in your luggage in a garbage bag to protect it from getting wet. We will be walking from building to building. Be prepared to walk in the rain and get wet.

- After lights-out during Sonic Sleep Time, youth participants may NOT leave their sleep zones unless escorted by a chaperone.

# Day 2 Exhibits to Explore on your own

The following exhibits are <u>areas that will not be visited during the Overnight Adventure</u> and may be seen on the second day of your Adventure.

#### Space Shuttle Atlantis<sup>™</sup>

Open all day. Allow two hours.

At Kennedy Space Center Visitor Complex, Space Shuttle Atlantis<sup>™</sup> is the new \$100 million home of the priceless, historic spacecraft that tells the incredible story of NASA's 30-year Space Shuttle Program.

Space Shuttle Atlantis features state-of-the-art multimedia presentations and more than 60 interactive exhibits and high-tech simulators that bring to life the complex systems and components behind this incredible feat of engineering. One of the most complicated and sophisticated pieces of equipment ever built, the shuttle is a vehicle that launched like a rocket, flew in orbit like a spacecraft and landed on a runway like a glider.

Open at 10:00 until park closes. Allow 30 minutes to 1 hour. This exhibit is located inside the Space Shuttle Atlantis<sup>SM</sup> building

Please note SLE can only be accessed inside the Space Shuttle Atlantis exhibit. Due to operations Overnight Adventure guests will not be able to ride this until the second day. Height restrictions 44". For large groups please note that each cabin holds 44 people. Your group may be split.

Shuttle Launch Experience® combines the detailed accounts of astronaut experiences with the expertise of premier design engineers to produce a true-to-life experience unique to visitor attractions around the world. The technical highlights include an amazingly realistic simulation of the space shuttle's eight and a half-minute ascent into orbit, custom-designed crew cabins with unprecedented vertical range, high-definition audiovisual effects, and advanced seating effects to maximize the sense of realism.
